


Transformational Effort Focused on Standardization and Industry Best Practices

- Ability to leverage electronic workflow capabilities while greatly reducing reliance on paper documents
- Digital signatures instead printing, signing and scanning
- Elimination of agency shadow systems (decreasing dual-entry or duplicative work)
- Integration of State's procurement processes

- Modern "Supplier Portal" allowing vendors to upload and monitor invoices or RFx responses
- Centralized functionality for accounts receivable processes
- Centralized functionality for grant and project accounting processes
- Improvements to document retention and recall
